Based at **Temple Basin**, the New Zealand Snow Safety Institute runs a series of courses through out the year on various aspects of mountaineering and mountain safety. These courses are for **climbers, skiers, snowboarders and trampers** who want to improve their understanding of the mountain environment in order to be safer in it.

All courses are led by **experienced and qualified instructors**, predominately selected by the specialised authority presenting the course.

You'll stay at the accommodation complex up at the Temple Basin Ski Area in Arthur's Pass National Park, which includes seminar facilities with all tuition aids, in a **splendid new lodge** with modern bunkrooms and service areas. Additional and/or **private courses** are available between 1 July and 3 October and can be tailored to your needs.

Equipment rental is available at Temple Basin. Check our website for details.

All course fees include instruction, accommodation, meals and GST.

#### **Multi-Skill Mountaineering Course - 7 days**

An intense alpine course covering all aspects including Winter survival, Snowcaving, Avalanche Awareness, Risk Management, Ropes Knots and Anchors. The ability to develop an understanding of the vagaries of mountain weather living high in an alpine environment will be of real advantage, as will the opportunity to observe the development of the snow pack over a long period, something not possible in a weekend avalanche awareness course. The development of climbing technique over different conditions is another great advantage.

**AUGUST 23 - 29 SEPTEMBER 13 - 19**  
**\$1,500 PER PERSON**

#### **Avalanche Awareness - 2 days**

This course is an ideal introduction for those skiers, snowboarders, climbers or trampers wishing to gain a basic level of understanding about avalanche safety. It covers terrain, weather, avalanche classification and formation, snow pack analysis, route finding and emergency procedures.

**JULY 17 - 18 JULY 31 - AUGUST 1 AUGUST 14 - 15**

#### **Mountain Skills Clinic - 2 days**

This course is designed for those people who wish to extend their basic mountaineering skills.

#### **Back Country Skills Skiers & Snowboarders - 5 days**

This course is designed for skiers and snowboarders who wish to develop experience and technical expertise in the back country. Some aspects of the course will be optional, but it will be possible for you to learn essential survival skills, spend a night in a snow cave, learn what to do when travelling on ridges and glaciers, avalanche awareness and many other skills for skiers and boarders wanting to go back country. We aim to provide you with a five day course that will allow you to safely explore the mountains off the beaten trail.

**AUGUST 9 - 13 AUGUST 23 - 27**  
**\$1 100 PER PERSON**

#### **Mountain Skills for Climbers and Trampers - 5 days**

This course is designed for climbers and trampers who wish to develop experience and technical expertise in the mountains. Some aspects of the course will be optional, but it will be possible for you to learn essential mountaineering skills, spend a night in a snow cave, learn what to do when travelling ridges and glaciers, avalanche awareness and many other skills for people wanting to head out into the mountains. We aim to provide you with a five day course that will allow you to safely explore the mountains.
